

Planning Guide

Planning your day:

First we'd like to congratulate you for taking this important decision in your life. Every wedding we have photographed has had its personal touch and we trust that your wedding will also be unique in its own way.

Obviously the most important step is deciding on your wedding date and the rest will fall into place. Please try to plan every step ahead to ensure you have a smooth day avoiding any unnecessary surprises.

Bookings Guide

We encourage you to make your bookings 12 months in advance if possible taking into consideration the following general points:

- Book your wedding date and ceremony time
- Enquire about specific venue and location guidelines such as decoration, music, dress code or photography lighting
- Make sure it's all signed in contract to avoid any misunderstanding
- Enquire about costs for additional required time

Ceremony venue or Church

- Organise ceremony music
- Enquire about pre-marital information packs and rehearsals
- Obtain copies of any readings or prayers of the faithful

Celebrant or Priest

- Confirm that they are happy to attend your ceremony venue or Church

Location shoot

- Allow a minimum of 2 hours for the location shoot
- Make sure you allow enough travel time after the wedding ceremony

Reception venue

- Make sure your start time allows enough travel and rest time after the location shoot
- Discuss your package such as food, drinks, colours, entertainment, get-away car, and most importantly service

Musician / DJ / Entertainment

- Book according to your program

Photographer

- View samples of their work and check the quality of their products
- Discuss your package in detail including hours, travel, high resolution images, albums, enlargements and delivery

Videographer

- View samples of their work and check their style of production
- Discuss your package in detail including hours, travel, number of cameras, highlights, full version and delivery

Florist

- Confirm specific delivery time
- Discuss a package such as decorating your home, ceremony venue, reception venue, bouquets etc.

Cars

- Confirm specific pick up and drop off times allowing for additional traffic
- Make sure you allow enough seating including booster seats if necessary

Beauty

- Book your hairdresser, makeup artist, nails, facial etc.
- Make sure they understand what works with photography and enquire about trials

General Guide

The following general points might also be required:

- Who to include as your bridal party, flower girls and page boys
- Decide on your colour scheme
- Organise your wedding rings
- Organise the wedding dress, suits and any other applicable clothing
- Organise your guest list, wedding invitations and seating plan
- Make sure you get plenty of rest the night before your wedding
- Have a good breakfast on your wedding morning and enjoy the rest of your day
